Course Overview

The class will focus on spoken English practice, using materials taken from the most popular tests for university students – TOEIC, Eiken and IELTS.

Course Goals

To give students the opportunity to practice as much spoken English as possible and provide them with the necessary skills to perform well in the speaking sections of the English tests mentioned above. The course will aim towards increasing general vocabulary and fluency, as well as providing techniques and advice specific to each test.

Course Content

Most classes will focus on content from a specific test, but some may be organized by theme, with practice questions from all 3 tests included.

General advice will be given about how to tackle each kind of test/question, before proceeding with question practice in pairs or small groups. Advice and feedback will be given at regular intervals. Classes will be conducted in English as much as possible, but each time students will be given a worksheet with useful words, phrases and idioms to help them tackle practice questions and themes.

Lesson Flow

- 1. General introduction to each specific test and the type of questions they include
- 2. Question practice in pairs or small groups
- 3. Feedback and advice
- 4. Repeat 2 & 3 as time allows
