The Second Mini-MUN

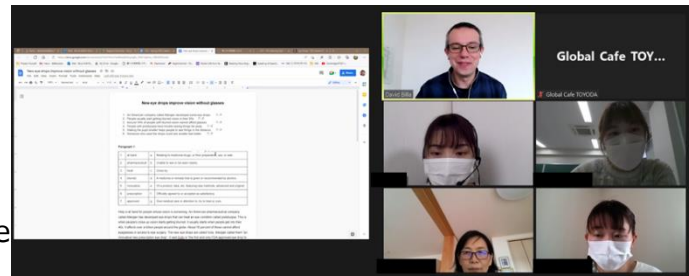
